Dear Family and Friends of TPCA,

Traders Point Christian Academy (TPCA) is committed to building academic and spiritual foundations in the lives of young people. I believe you are someone who also values that commitment.

To provide the ongoing, sustaining financial resources to enhance our academic achievement and spiritual growth, we have created the *Building Foundations* fund. This fund makes up the difference between the actual cost of a TPCA education and tuition income. For this academic year the total need is \$400,000.
